A Few Notes

- Online orders are preferred over mail orders. If you'd like to order by mail, please call the office to confirm that we have your seedlings available. Orders cannot always be guaranteed because we order seedlings months in advance. It is not always practical or feasible to order more seedlings to fulfill orders.
- Online ordering is easy and simple at www.kalkaskaconservation.org at "District Store"
- Payment is required at the time of ordering. Payments can be arranged on bulk orders. Checks/money orders are payable to: Kalkaska Conservation District or KCD (Returned checks are subject to a \$25 fee.)
- You will get an email or call reminder the week before your trees are ready for pick-up. If you cannot pick your order up in person, please contact staff to make arrangements. Others may pick your order up for you.
- Orders received after the April 11 deadline cannot be guaranteed.
